

About the Author: Robbie Bach


Robbie Bach joined Microsoft in 1988. Over the next twenty-two years, he worked in various marketing, general management, and business leadership roles, including supporting the successful launch and expansion of Microsoft Office. As Chief Xbox Officer, he led the creation and development of the Xbox business, including the launch of the Xbox and its highly popular successor, the Xbox 360. He retired from Microsoft as the president of the Entertainment and Devices Division in 2010.

In his new role as a civic engineer, Robbie works with corporate, philanthropic, and civic organizations that are driving positive change in our communities. He guest lectures extensively at various colleges and universities and speaks to corporate, civic, and trade association audiences across the country. In 2015, he published his first book, Xbox Revisited: A Game Plan for Corporate and Civic Renewal. His debut novel featuring Tamika Smith, The Wilkes Insurrection, was published in 2021.

He is the former chairman and current board member at the Bipartisan Policy Center. 
Suggested Questions

- 1. The Blockchain Syndicate weaves together cyber threats, financial sabotage, and political corruption. What sparked the idea for this storyline?
- 2. In The Wilkes Insurrection, we first met Senator Tamika Smith as she confronted a domestic terror conspiracy that threatened the nation. In *The Blockchain Syndicate*, she faces an even more complex web of threats. How has Tamika evolved as a character between these two books, and what inspired you to continue her story?
- 3. What was the most difficult part about writing the book?
- 4. Your background is in tech and business, not politics. How did that inform the way you approached this novel?
- 5. How close to reality is the threat posed by blockchain in the book?
- 6. You describe your current role as a "civic engineer." Can you explain what that means and how it connects to your writing?
- 7. The Blockchain Syndicate explores disinformation as a tool of destabilization. How concerned are you about its actual impact in the real world?
- 8. You've written both nonfiction (Xbox Revisited) and fiction. What different muscles do those require?
- 9. The pacing in your thrillers feels very cinematic. Do you see them as potential screen adaptations?
- 10. What role do you think fiction plays in helping us navigate and process complex issues, such as national security and tech ethics?
- 11. How has your work with organizations like the Bipartisan Policy Center influenced your perspective on democracy and resilience?
- 12. There's a school shooting in the book that sets off a major plot thread. How did you approach writing about such a sensitive issue?



Suggested Questions

- 13. What are the ethical responsibilities of tech leaders in an age of rapid innovation and unintended consequences?
- 14. Many of your villains are morally complex, not cartoonish. Why is that important to you?
- 15. How has the reception of The Wilkes Insurrection shaped the direction of this second book?
- 16. How do you research geopolitical and cybersecurity issues for your novels?
- 17. You served on boards for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America, the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic Committee and Habitat for Humanity. Have those experiences influenced your characters or stories?
- 18. What do you hope readers will think differently about after finishing *The Blockchain Syndicate*?
- 19. How do you balance entertainment with deeper commentary in your storytelling?
- 20. What's next for Tamika Smith? Is a third installment already underway?

His America.


